



2020 Grand Rivers Trunk – Or – Treat Guidelines & Set-Up Information

The event will take place at Grand Rivers Community Center, located at 155 W. Cumberland Ave.

Thank you for your interest in the Grand Rivers Trunk or Treat event! This is the 3rd year for the event with the event growing each year. There is no cost to enter but you must be prepared to hand out candy/prizes to Trunk or Treaters. This is a traditional event where families, organizations, businesses, or groups decorate an area indoors or a table, golf cart or vehicle outdoors with a Halloween theme and pass out goodies to the children who attend. Participants are encouraged to dress in costume but, it is not required. Participants should be prepared to hand out candy/prizes to 100 – 150 attendees. It is not required to register for the event and participants may show-up without notice to decorate a “treat station” or vehicle, however, registering at <https://www.grandrivers.org/event> will help us determine space needed and make set-up more efficient.

“Treat Station” Options/Set-Up Times

- **Indoor Treat Station** – 8’ x 8’ space (marked and 6’ from next station), tables & chairs provided if needed. Can be decorated as simple or as elaborate as you choose. Feel free to use any sets or props to make your station stand out. Inside the Grand Rivers Community Center. *Indoor Treat Stations can be set-up Friday, October 30, from 1 p – 4 p, and Saturday October 31, from 10 a – 4 p.*
- **Outdoor Treat Station** - 8’ x 4’ space (6’ from the next station), table & chair provided if needed. Space allows for 1 – 8’ table and will be located on the porch of the Grand Rivers Community Center. *Outdoor Treat Stations can be set-up Saturday October 31, from 10 a – 4 p.*
- **Vehicles** – Cars, Trucks, SUVs, Golf Carts, and Side-by-Sides may be decorated for a traditional Trunk-Or-Treat treat station. The parking lot between First Kentucky Bank & the Grand Rivers Community Center will be used for vehicles. *Vehicle Treat Stations can be set-up Saturday October 31, from 2 p – 4 p.*

Set-Up is first come, first serve.

Decoration Contest:

ALL Treat Stations will be judged at 4:30 pm with the winner of the “best decorated” station receiving \$100.

Guidelines:

- Keep decorations family friendly. This is an event for kids and families.
- Be prepared with enough treats/candy/prizes for 150 children.
- All edible items must be store bought or prepared on-site and must be individually wrapped.
- Please have space set-up by 4 pm, October 31, 2020. Doors open promptly at 5 pm.
- By participating you acknowledge that you/your station may be photographed and used in promotional material by Grand Rivers Chamber, Grand Rivers Tourism, and/or the City of Grand Rivers.
- Most importantly – HAVE FUN!

Safety Ideas:

- Place candy in trick-or-treaters bags (don't let them grab from bucket)
- Wear gloves when passing out candy (gloves will be provided, if needed)
- Consider making individual treat bags filled with your goodies
- Encourage social distancing when possible
