AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 02-99 A WATER RATE ORDINANCE THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS, KENTUCKY. 9

WHEREAS: the City must comply with regulations as mandated by the Kentucky Division of Water pertaining to storage, volume and pressure in the water system, and

WHEREAS: the City must enter into a long term bonded debt to provide these water system improvements, and

WHEREAS: twenty (20) years the City must increase rates to repay the indebtedness over a period of

Now therefore the City of Grand Rivers does ordain:

- SECTION 1. A monthly five-dollar (\$5.00) surcharge will be added to each water meter beginning with the January 2002 water billing that is due and payable on or before February 15, 2002.
- SECTION 2. All surcharge collections will be used for debt retirement only, not to exceed twenty (20) years and, placed into a special fund for said purpose
- SECTION 3. When the water system improvement debt is satisfied the surcharge will be rescinded.
- SECTION 4. The surcharge will be effective upon publication
