

ORDINANCE 01-2006

AN ORDINANCE FINALIZING THE CLOSING OF A CERTAIN RIGHT-OF-WAY  
LYING WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS

WHEREAS: The City Council of The City of Grand Rivers has found the right-of-ways of all and or parts of the City Streets referred to in the Ordinance have never been opened for public use. And,

WHEREAS: The adjoining property owners have requested that the City Street referred to in this Ordinance running through their property be closed.

WHEREAS: The City Council Recognizes the official plat of the City of Grand Rivers which outlines the street right-of-ways and alleys as shown on deed book 16, page 630 of the Livingston County Clerk records.

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS KENTUCKY DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. All parts of the Streets as follows.

That Part of Suwanee Avenue beginning at the North end of lot # 28 block 9 (IX) and JH O'Bryan Avenue thence running in an Easterly direction intersecting with the West side of Barkley Drive a distance of 465'+or- X 60' according to the official plat of The City of Grand Rivers.

All alleyways that run parallel and perpendicular to each street as listed herein are included in this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. The City Council of Grand Rivers Kentucky is hereby authorized empowered and directed to institute, prosecute and notify pursuant to KRS 82.405 an action in Livingston Co. Circuit Court for a Judgment ordering the closing of all parts of streets and alleyways described herein.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be read on two (2) Separate days and will become effective upon publication of title and a certified summary thereof.
