AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE PROCEEDURE BY WHICH THE CITY WILL MAKE WIRELESS INTERNET SERVICE AVAILABLE.

WHEREAS, the Grand Rivers city council desires to make wireless Internet service available

BE IT ORDAINED by the city council of the City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky as follows:

, - PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to make wireless Internet service available

PROCEDURE

The city will make wireless Internet service available for a fee. As a precondition to the city providing wireless Internet service to a customer, each customer shall execute a service agreement on a form provided by the city.

Ħ, COLLECTION COSTS

incurred by the city in collecting payment due to the city for wireless Internet service provided to the customer and for any cause for action arising from breach of the service agreement. The city shall be entitled to recover from the customer all costs and reasonable attorney's fees

Ŗ SEVERABILITY

provision, section, paragraph, sentence, or part thereof, or the application thereof to any person, license, class, or group is held by a court of law to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such holding shall not affect or impair the remainder of this ordinance, it being the legislative intent to ordain and enact each provision, section, paragraph, sentence, and part thereof separately and independently of the rest Each section and each provision of each section of this ordinance are provision, paragraph, scverable,

This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its publication.
