

ORDINANCE 01-2016

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2016 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2017 FOR THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS; a public hearing was held on the proposed budget at 5:30 pm on the 14th day of June 2016 and;

WHEREAS; the City must provide revenue to fund operations of the city and;

WHEREAS; the City must impose guidelines for expenditures of revenue sources and;

WHEREAS; the City's budget proposal was presented to the legislative body and, WHEREAS; the City by this ordinance does make appropriations for funding City Government operations for the forthcoming fiscal year:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS:


SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon publication but not earlier than the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July 2016.
