

ORDINANCE NO. 01-2018

COMPENSATION OF NON-ELECTED CITY OFFICERS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 04-2015 RELATING TO COMPENSATION FOR NON-ELECTED CITY OFFICERS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky recognizes it is in the best interest of the City to provide fair and competitive compensation to non-elected city officers; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky set forth a compensation schedule for non-elected city officers in Ordinance 04-2015; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky recognizes the need to amend the City's compensation schedule for non-elected city officers;

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF GRAND RIVERS, KENTUCKY DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 04-2015 Section 1 is amended as follows:

The office of City Administrative Officer shall have a salary of \$42,000 and not to exceed \$50,000 per year. The office of Utility Manager shall have a salary of \$45,000 and not to exceed \$50,000 ~~\$55,000~~ per year. The office of City Clerk shall have a yearly salary of \$25,000 and not to exceed \$35,000 per year.

SECTION 2. Severability.

If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of the same shall not effect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. Ordinances in Conflict Repealed.

All Ordinances, resolutions, orders, or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, but only to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Enactment.

This ordinance shall be read on two (2) separate days and will become effective upon publication of title and certified summary thereof.


