Beginning July 1, 2023

SECTION 6:Rate Increases:

All usage rates for water and sewer services gallonage shall annually increase in an amount equal to the annual increase, if any, in the consumer price index. Increases shall be calculated in March of each year based upon the consumer price index published by the United States Department of Labor in February of that year for the "All Items" category. Rates per gallon for both water and sewer usage shall increase in a percentage equal to the percentage increase in the consumer price index

All ordinances, orders, resolutions, motions or parts thereof insofar as some may be in conflict herewith are repealed.

This ordinance shall be published and take effect thereafter.
