

ORDINANCE 01-95

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 05-94  
BUDGET APPROPRIATION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR  
JULY 1, 1994 THROUGH JUNE 30, 1995

WHEREAS, the city of Grand Rivers, Kentucky received a Grant from the Department of Local Government for the construction of a Senior Citizens Center and,

WHEREAS, the City will receive cash payments monthly until a total of \$310,470 [three hundred ten thousand, four hundred seventy dollars] has been expended and,

WHEREAS, the City must incorporate the amount of the Grant into the 1994-1995 General Fund Budget.

Now therefore the City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky does ordain that,

The General Fund Budget for the fiscal year 1994-1995 be amended to reflect \$310,470 [three hundred ten thousand, four hundred seventy dollars] that will be available for the Senior Citizen Center.
