

ORDINANCE 02-2002

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION FOR FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2002 THRU JUNE 30, 2003 FOR THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, a budget proposal plan of services and capital improvements for the City was presented to the City Council on the 25th day of June, 2002 and,
WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on the proposed budget on the 25th day of June 2002.

Now therefore be it ordained by the City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky:
