GOLF CARTS

AN ORDINANCE CREATING NEW PROVISIONS TO THE GRAND RIVERS CODE OF ORDINANCES AND AUTHORIZING THE USE OF GOLF CARTS ON CERTAIN DESIGNATED CITY STREETS

use of golf carts on certain city streets; WHEREAS, KRS 189.286 was enacted by the Kentucky General Assembly which authorizes the

provisions of KRS 189.286; course if the City adopts an ordinance specifying each roadway that is open for golf cart use; and public roadway under its jurisdiction that lies within five (5) road miles of an entrance to a golf WHEREAS, the City Council deems it appropriate and necessary to formally adopt the WHEREAS, KRS 189.286 authorizes the City to regulate the operation of a golf cart on any

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF GRAND RIVERS, KENTUCKY DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Definitions

For the purpose of this ordinance the following definitions shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning.

Golf cart means any self-propelled vehicle that:

- 9 Is designed for the transportation of players or maintaining equipment on a or maintaining the condition of the grounds on a golf course; golf course, while engaged in the playing of golf, supervising the play of golf,
- b. Has a minimum of four (4) wheels;
- 9 Is designed to operate at a speed of not more than thirty-five (35) miles per
- ? Is designed to carry not more than six (6) persons including the driver;
- σ Has a maximum gross vehicle weight of two thousand five hundred (2,500)
- Ţ pounds; and Has a maximum rated payload capacity of one thousand two hundred (1,200)
- úσ forth in 49 CFR 571.500. Meets the federal motor vehicle safety standards for low-speed vehicles set

Local government means a city, county, charter county government, urban-county government, consolidated local government, unified local government, or a special district

SECTION 2. Adoption of KRS 189.286

five (35) miles per hour or less. In compliance with the provision of KRS 189.286 and this Ordinance, golf carts may be operated on the following designated City streets attached as Appendix A whose speed limits are thirty

SECTION 3. Operation Requirements

In order to be operated on such designated city streets, a golf cart shall:

(1) Be issued a permit for the golf cart by the City;

- (2) Display a sticker or permit that identifies that the golf cart is allowed to be operated on specific roadways within the City; and
- complies with the requirements of this section. The inspection fee under this paragraph shall be office and certified through the Department of Vehicle Regulation to ensure that the golf cart five dollars (\$5). Inspections shall occur at Grand Rivers City Hall. (3) Be inspected by a certified inspector designated by the Livingston County Sheriff's
- (4) Display a slow-moving vehicle emblem in compliance with KRS 189.820
- proof of insurance shall be inside the golf cart at all times of operation on a public roadway (5) Be insured in compliance with KRS 304.39-080 by the owner or operator, and the
- (6) Be operated only between sunrise and sunset;
- (7) Be operated by a person with a valid operator's license in his or her possession;
- (8) Display a safety flag which extends not less than seven (7) feet above ground, dayglow in color, be triangular in shape with an area of not less than thirty (30) square inches. ě
- (9) Be outfitted with headlights and tail lights to be operated at all times

SECTION 4. Application of Traffic Regulations

this Code of Ordinances pertaining to the operation of vehicles upon City streets. Any person operating a golf cart on a public roadway under the provisions of this Chapter shall be subject to the traffic regulations of KRS Chapter 189 and any other applicable provisions of

SECTION 5. Motor Vehicle Requirement Exemptions

A golf cart operating on a public roadway is not considered to be a motor vehicle and is exempt

- (1) Title requirements of KRS 186.020;
 (2) Vehicle registration requirements of KRS 186.050; and
 (3) Emissions compliance certificates pursuant to KRS 224.20-720

SECTION 6. Exempted Golf Carts

The provisions of these sections shall not apply to a golf cart that is not used on a public roadway except to cross a roadway while following a golf cart path on a golf course

SECTION 7. Penalty

fined not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$200.00. Upon an individuals third conviction of an offense hereunder, the individual's permit shall be revoked for three (3) years in addition to any fine. Failure to pay any fine within thirty (30) days due to a violation of this Ordinance shall Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction of a first offense, be fined not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$100.00. Any person convicted of a subsequent violation of this Ordinance, within five years of a prior conviction under this Ordinance, shall be result in suspension of permit.

SECTION 8. Enactment

This ordinance shall be read on two (2) separate days and will become effective upon publication of title and certified summary thereof.
