

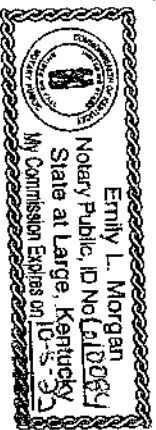

ORDINANCE 02-2021

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2021 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2022 FOR THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on the proposed budget at 5:25 pm on the 8th day of June 2021 and,

WHEREAS, the City must provide revenue to fund operations of the city and,

WHEREAS, the City must impose guidelines for expenditures of revenue sources and,

WHEREAS, the City's budget proposal was presented to the legislative body and,

WHEREAS, the City by this ordinance does make appropriations for funding City Government operations for the forthcoming fiscal year:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS:

SECTION 1. The following budget is adopted for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022 and the amounts stated are appropriated for the purposes as outlined:
