

ORDINANCE 04-98

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO EXTRA CHARGES PERTAINING TO THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS WATER AND SEWER UTILITIES.

WHEREAS, the city has a need to cover the cost of collecting delinquent accounts which is not presently sufficient and,

WHEREAS, a meter testing procedure needs to be initiated and,

WHEREAS, a service connection or re-connection charge needs to be put in place as it is now inadequate and,

WHEREAS, now the city must take this means to prohibit connecting more than one residential or commercial building onto a single meter. Each unit shall have its own meter, and any area where this presently exists shall pay an additional facility charge.

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS, KENTUCKY DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. A Charge of ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be charged for city personnel to make a trip to a delinquent person, even if said account is paid prior to disconnection, the fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be charged if necessary for city employees to appear at the property to remove the meter or collect the bill. A re-connection charge of twenty dollars (\$20.00) shall be made if reconnected during regular business hours. If reconnected at any time other than regular working hours, the charge shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00).

Section 2. Upon request and payment of five dollars (\$5.00), a customer may have his meter tested, provided said request by the customer is not more frequent than once per twelve (12) month period. If such test shows the meter to be more than two percent (2%) fast, a refund of the five dollar (\$5.00) testing charge shall be made and the bill adjusted accordingly.

Section 3. A charge of twenty dollars (\$20.00) shall be made for all service re-connections made during regular working hours, except that there shall be no connection charges made for service on the original installation of facilities. If service is reconnected other than during regular working hours, the charge shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00).

Section 4. All current users of the cities water and sewer service shall pay an additional nine dollars (\$9.00) per month for water service at each residential unit or commercial establishment connected to and or using water thru one or the same meter.

Section 5. All current users of the city's water and sewer service shall pay an additional six dollars and seventy-five cents (\$6.75) per month for sewer service at each residential unit or commercial establishment connected to and/or discharging waste-water into the same discharge pipe connected to the City sewer collection system.

Section 6. all other ordinances of record that may be in conflict with this ordinance or any section thereof shall be null and void.


