

ORDINANCE 04-97

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO RESTRUCTURING OF RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE GRAND RIVERS WATER SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, The City has not changed or restructured the rates for use of water from its system for a period of nineteen (19) years, and

WHEREAS, The system has grown within and without to the point that purchasing supplemental water has become necessary, and

WHEREAS, The City has reached a limit of absorbing the increase in cost of labor, supplies, and equipment, and

WHEREAS, The City must restructure its rates at this time.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS TO REVISE THE WATER RATE STRUCTURE.

SECTION 1. The following rates for monthly water service shall be as follows:

The first 2000 gallons, or less, per month \$9.00 minimum. All over 2000 gallons per month \$2.30 per 1000 gallons.

SECTION 2. No two residences, buildings, or structures shall be connected to a single meter without prior written approval by authorized city personnel. All such existing multiple connections shall be subject to an additional minimum billing.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and this ordinance shall take effect upon approval and publication.
