

CITY OF GRAND RIVERS

ORDINANCE 03-97

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO REPEAL OF OUTDATED AND IRRELEVANT AND  
NON-ENFORCEABLE ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, the City has entered into a contract with the State of Kentucky and received a grant to upgrade, code and revise all ordinances; and,

WHEREAS, many ordinances that were enacted over the past one hundred years are no longer relevant to the present, being outdated, not enforceable due to state statutory changes and etc.,

WHEREAS, the City desires to bring all other ordinances up to date, properly coded and filed.  
NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL DOES ORDAIN THAT ALL ORDINANCES AS LISTED BY SUBJECT AND ENACTED BY DATE AND YEAR ARE HEREBY REPEALED.

SECTION 1: An ordinance prohibiting the sale of soft drinks and cigars on Sunday, 5-4-1914.

SECTION 2: Contract with ICRR, 8-3-1914.

SECTION 3: Contract with ICRR, 8-8-1914.

SECTION 4: Establishing the salary for police court judges, 8-7-1933.

SECTION 5: Establishing fines for drunk and disorderly conduct, 8-3-1936.

SECTION 6: Change of meeting place for the city council meetings, 1-6-1936.

SECTION 7: Establishing hourly labor rates, 3-1937.

SECTION 8: Repealing ordinance enacted 8-3-1936, 8-1-1938.

SECTION 9: Establishing a flat tax on all unimproved lots, 8-1-1938.

SECTION 10: Change of fiscal year, 12-6-1938.

SECTION 11: Prohibiting dogs from running at large for one month, 12-6-1938.

SECTION 12: Establishing fines for not purchasing city license within a specified time, 3-10-1939.

SECTION 13: Extending ordinance pertaining to salaries, 12-4-1944.

SECTION 14: Establishing license for juke boxes and other amusement games, 12-1951.

SECTION 15: Establishing license rates and fines for places of amusements, 2-19-1953.

SECTION 16: This ordinance shall become effective upon publication.
