ORDINANCE 06-96

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO EMPLOYEE CLASSIFICATION AND COMPENSATION

Be it ordained by the City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 03-94 amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2. There is hereby established the following classifications, number, and hourly rate of employees that may be used in the operation of city activities.

a. Maintenance Employee	2	\$7.15/hr	\$10.00/hr
b. Maintenance Helper	2	\$6.60/hr	\$7.00/hr
c. Water Plant Operator	4	\$7.15/hr	\$10.00/hr
d. Sewer Plant Operator	4	\$7.15/hr	\$10.00/hr
e. Water Distribution Operator	4	\$7.15/hr	\$8.00/hr
f. Sewer Collection System Operator	2	\$275/me	\$7.00/hr
g. Water Plant Operator Trainee	2	\$209/me	\$6.00/hr
h. Sewer Plant Operator Trainee	2	\$209/me	\$6.00/hr
i. Trainee (any class. except labor)	4	\$5.50/hr	\$5.50/hr
j. Equipment Operator	2	\$7.50/hr	\$10.00/hr
k. Clerical-Bookkeeper	2	\$5.50/hr	\$7.00/hr
l. Laborer	4	\$5.50/hr	\$5.75/hr

SECTION 3. This ordinance will become effective immediately upon passage and publication.
