ORDINANCE 03-96

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CHANGE OF TIME, DAY AND PLACE OF THE MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL WHEREAS THE CITY COUNCIL HAS ALWAYS MET ON THE FIRST MONDAY EVENING OF EACH MONTH AT 7:00 P.M. ON A REGULAR BASIS AND,

WHEREAS, because of the increase in the time it takes to transact the city's business it is necessary to convene earlier in the evening so that adjournment will not come so late.

**NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF GRAND RIVERS, KENTUCKY DOES ORDAIN:**

SECTION 1. The meeting day of the City Council is changed from the first (1st) Monday in each month to the second (2nd) Tuesday in each month on a regular basis.


SECTION 2. The time when the City Council shall convene shall be at 5:00 o'clock P.M..

SECTION 3. The place that the City Council shall meet on a regular basis will be in City Hall located at 122 West Cumberland Avenue in Grand Rivers, Kentucky.


SECTION 4. All other ordinances of record which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.


