

CITY OF GRAND RIVERS

ORDINANCE 01-96

AN ORDINANCE FINALIZING THE CLOSING OF A CERTAIN PUBLIC WAY
LYING WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY AND KNOWN AS WABASH AVENUE.

WHEREAS, the City of Grand Rivers has determined that public way known as Wabash Avenue should be closed,

WHEREAS, all property owners abutting all or any portion of public way have been identified and notified

WHEREAS, all property owners abutting all or any portion of the public way have given notarized consent to the closing.

WHEREAS, KRS 82.405 provides that a public way may be closed if all necessary requirements are met.

WHEREAS, all requirements have been met.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS,
KENTUCKY:

SECTION 1: It is the intent of the city to close the public way known as Wabash Avenue which lies within the City of Grand Rivers and is more particularly described as follows:

Begin at an iron pin in the center line of Wabash Avenue NE, thence in a northerly direction 30 feet to the north and east line of Wabash Avenue and the southwest corner of the Brenda Lady property; thence in a northerly direction 133.22 feet to the U.S. Corps of Engineers fence line. thence south 60 feet with the Corps of Engineers fence line to the south line of Wabash Avenue and the corner of the David Jackson property, thence in a westerly direction with the David Jackson property line 133.22 feet, thence in a northerly direction 30 feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2: In accordance with KRS 82.405, the city council makes the following finding of fact.

1. The property owners abutting all or any portion of the public way have been identified as Brenda Lady and David Jackson.

2. Written notice of the proposed closing was given to all property owners in or abutting the public way or portion thereof being closed.

3. All property owners in or abutting the public way or portion thereof being closed have given their written notarized consent to the closing. (Copies of the consent are attached hereto)

SECTION 3: All statutory requirements having been met, the public way known as a portion of Wabash Avenue is hereby closed.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be read on two separate days and upon publication the Public Way described above shall be closed.
