AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS ESTABLISHING A CITY TOURISM COMMISSION PURSUANT TO KRS 91A.350 AND IMPOSING A TRANSIENT ROOM TAX PURSUANT TO KRS 91A.390 AND IMPOSING A RESTAURANT TAX PURSUANT TO KRS 91A.400

WHEREAS, the City desires to promote tourism in the community and

WHEREAS, the City supports the need for a commission to promote this need

the Grand Rivers Tourism Commission. Said commission shall have all of the powers conferred provided in section 91A.350 et. seq. of the Kentucky Revised Statutes which shall be known as Municipal Code to read as follows: That their shall be established a tourism commission as upon such commissions under Chapter 91a of the Kentucky Revised Statutes. The City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky does ordain that Title 9 is added to the Grand Rivers
