

ORDINANCE 05-99

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to initiate a sound planning process for the City and,

WHEREAS, a planning commission has been appointed by the mayor and approved by the City Council and,

WHEREAS, the planning commission has diligently pursued its agenda and,

WHEREAS, the planning commission has prepared a comprehensive plan for the City,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS,

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.

SECTION 1. Title 8 is added to the Grand Rivers Municipal Code and is adopted by reference as if fully spelled out in the code.

SECTION 2. The Comprehensive Plan, which, states the goals and objectives of the City are contained in the Comprehensive Plan is hereby, approved to read as follows: A copy of the plan is on file at City Hall and may be inspected during regular business hours Monday through Friday.

SECTION 3. All other ordinances previously enacted which, are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance becomes effective on and after its adoption and publication.
