

ORDINANCE NO 03-2022

RESTAURANT TAX ORDINANCE AMENDMENT

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 01-2000 REVISING THE RATE OF THE RESTAURANT TAX ON RETAIL FOOD AND BEVERAGE SALES

WHEREAS, The City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky adopted Ordinance 01-2000, which established the Grand Rivers Tourism Commission; and  
WHEREAS, City of Grand Rivers Ordinance 01-2000 implemented a restaurant tax of one percent on food and beverage retail sales to fund the Grand Rivers Tourism Commission; and  
WHEREAS, the City Council deems it appropriate and necessary to amend the provisions of Ordinance 01-2000 to provide increased funding for the Grand Rivers Tourism Commission;

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF GRAND RIVERS, KENTUCKY DOES ORDAIN:

CITY OF GRAND RIVERS ORDINANCE 01-2000 IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 3. That the City of Grand Rivers shall provide additional funds for the operation of the Commission by imposing, pursuant to KRS 91A.400, a restaurant tax of ~~one~~ **two** percent (**2**%) of the food and beverage retail sales by all restaurants and clubs, private or public doing business in the city. The effective date of this restaurant tax shall be May 1, 2000.

This ordinance shall be read on two (2) separate days and will become effective upon publication of title and certified summary thereof but not earlier than January 1, 2023.







Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Rivers:

**Section 1:** For the purpose of obtaining revenue for the general operating expenses of the City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky, the ad valorem tax rate is set at .002960 per \$100 of assessment of all real property, .002960 per \$100 of assessment on all personal property, and .002960 per \$100 of assessment of all motor vehicles and watercraft situated within the city limits of Grand Rivers, Kentucky.

**Section 2:** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such infirmity shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

**Section 3:** Any and all other ordinances, or portions thereof, inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby automatically repealed.

**Section 4:** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its date of passage and publication according to law.

**Section 4:** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its date of passage and publication according to law.
