

CITY OF GRAND RIVERS

ORDINANCE 04-2000

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO EMPLOYEE CLASSIFICATION AND COMPENSATION

WHEREAS; the City has established job classifications for the type of work to be performed by each employee, and

WHEREAS; the City must establish a rate of pay for each classification, and

WHEREAS; due to economics and related issues the city must adjust and increase the maximum wage for each classification listed.

Now therefore be it ordained by the City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky:

SECTION 1. Section 3.04.020 of the Grand Rivers Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2. Ordinance 06-96 is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. There is hereby established the following classifications, number, and hourly rate of employees that may be used in the operation of city activities.

| h. Sewer Plant Operator Trainee      | 2 | <del>\$ 6.00/hr</del> | \$ 8.00 |
| i. Trainee (any class. except labor) | 4 | <del>\$ 5.50/hr</del> | \$ 6.50 |
| j. Equipment Operator                | 2 | <del>\$10.00/hr</del> | \$15.00 |
| k. Clerical-Bookkeeper               | 2 | <del>\$ 7.00/hr</del> | \$ 8.00 |
| l. Laborer                           | 4 | <del>\$ 5.75/hr</del> | \$ 7.00 |
