- Section 1. to read as follows Subsection C is added to § 9.04.020 of the Grand Rivers Municipal
- Section 2 following the close of each calender quarter. All room and restaurant taxes shall be paid no later than thirty (30) days
- Section 3 There shall be imposed a penalty of ten percent (10%) on any unpaid balance of the room and restaurant tax on the thirty-first (31st) day following the close of the calender quarter. There shall begin to accrue, attach and be added on said date, interest at the rate of six percent [6%] per annum from said date until taxes are paid.
- Section 4. within 30 days relevant to exacted penalties and interest. Taxpayer may request in writing an appeal to the City Council for relief
