

ORDINANCE 04-2005

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATIONS
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2005 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2006 FOR THE CITY OF
GRAND RIVERS, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on the proposed budget on the 14th day of June 2005 and,
WHEREAS, the City must provide revenue to fund operations of the city and,
WHEREAS, the City must impose guidelines for expenditures of revenue sources and,
WHEREAS, the City's budget proposal was presented to the legislative body and,
WHEREAS, the City by this ordinance does make appropriations for funding City Government
operations for the forthcoming fiscal year:




