

ORDINANCE 04-2012

AN ORDINANCE FINALIZING THE TRANSFER AND LEGAL OWNERSHIP OF LITTLE LAKE VILLAGE DRIVE FROM TODD THOMASON, DEVELOPER OF LITTLE LAKE VILLAGE SUBDIVISION TO THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, Todd Thomason the developer of Little Lake Village subdivision has designed and constructed the right-of-way Little Lake Village Drive to the road specifications of the City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, the right-of-way has been legally permitted by the US Army Corps of Engineers; and


WHEREAS, the developer Todd Thomason wishes to transfer legal ownership and maintenance of Little Lake Village Drive to the City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, the City of Grand Rivers desires to accept legal ownership and maintenance of Little Lake Village Drive.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS;

Section 1. That the ownership and maintenance of the right-of-way of Little Lake Village Drive is herewith transferred to the City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky.

Section 2. That the area of the Little Lake Village Drive right-of-way running north from the intersection of East Commerce Street is a distance of 600 feet, a paved surface of 22 feet in width and 14 feet of utility easement on each side, a total easement of 50 feet.
