SECTION 6. That a discount of <u>2.0</u> percent [2%] be allowed on all taxes of one dollar [\$1.00] or more paid by November 30, 2019. That the "total tax due" be collected from the first day of December 2017 through the thirty-first day of December 2019.

Likewise, and in addition thereto, upon all taxes levied herein which shall be unpaid on the first day of January, 2020, there shall be attached and added a penalty of 10.0 percent interest at the rate of 6.0 percent [6%] per annum from said date until said taxes are paid day of January 2020, there shall begin to accrue, attach and be added on said date SECTION 7. That upon all taxes levied herewith which are unpaid on the first

interest as provided herein shall be added to said unpaid taxes and collected by the City [10%] flat unto the total amount of said taxes then due and payable, which penalty and Administrative Officer or City Clerk together with said due and unpaid taxes.
