

ORDINANCE NO 05-2018

NUISANCE ORDINANCE AMENDMENT

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 05-2005 ESTABLISHING CERTAIN CONDITIONS AS NUISANCES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

WHEREAS, The City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky adopted Ordinance 05-2005 which set forth certain conditions as nuisances and provided penalties for violation of the same; WHEREAS, The City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky desires to keep all property in a maintained, organized and clean manner within the city; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it appropriate and necessary to amend the provisions of Ordinance 05-2005;

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF GRAND RIVERS, KENTUCKY DOES ORDAIN:

CITY OF GRAND RIVERS ORDINANCE 05-2005 IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS

INOPERATIVE CONDITION. Unable to move under its own power due to defective or missing parts, and which has remained in such condition for a period of not less than ten consecutive days. A motor vehicle shall be presumed to be in an inoperative condition if any required registration for the vehicle is not in full force and effect for greater than thirty (30) days.

SECTION 3. CERTAIN CONDITIONS DECLARED A NUISANCE

1. ~~General prohibition of noise. It shall be unlawful for any person to make, continue, or cause or allow to be made or continued any noise disturbance. Accumulation of brush. The accumulation or storage of brush, including, but not limited to, tree limbs, bushes, or any other vegetative substance which can be seen or observed from the roadway.~~

~~K. Odor. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to cause or allow to be made offensive or unsanitary odors.~~

SECTION 4. ABATEMENT PROCEDURE.

Whenever a nuisance situation is discovered, the authorized city official shall give five to thirty days written notice to remedy the nuisance situation.

This ordinance shall be read on two (2) separate days and will become effective upon publication of title and certified summary thereof.




