

ORDINANCE 06-2003

AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 05-1996 RELATING TO AN INCREASE IN SEWER SERVICE RATES.

WHEREAS, The City of Grand Rivers owns and operates a sanitary sewer treatment and collection system, and

WHEREAS, The City of Grand Rivers last revised the rate structure in 1996, and

WHEREAS, The City of Grand Rivers has absorbed with that rate structure the annual increase in the cost of operation and maintenance of the sewerage facilities to date, and

WHEREAS, The regulatory burden imposed by EPA and the Kentucky Division of Water and OSHA regulations requires that the City must modify and upgrade the treatment and collection system, and

WHEREAS, The City of Grand Rivers must revise the rate structure to overcome increased cost factors in order to have sufficient revenues to operate maintain and upgrade the facilities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS, KENTUCKY.

SECTION 1. Ordinance 05-1996 is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2. The monthly rate for sewerage service shall be:

Zero (0) gallons - \$4.75 minimum service charge.

~~[First 2000 gallons - \$6.75 minimum]~~

All gallons registered on each water service meter shall be \$6.00 per each 1000 gallons.

~~[All over 2000 gallons - \$3.25 per 1000 gallons metered water]~~

SECTION 3. Any and all existing ordinances inconsistent with this amendment are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon publication.
