

ORDINANCE 06-2005

WHEREAS; The City Council of Grand Rivers has found the Rights-of-Ways of all and or parts of the city street referred to in this Ordinance have never been opened for public use. And,

WHEREAS; the adjoining property owners have requested that the city street referred to in this Ordinance running through their property be closed.

WHEREAS; The City Council recognizes the official plat of the City of Grand Rivers which outlines the street right-of-ways and alleys as shown on deed book 16, page 630 of the Livingston County Court House records.

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF GRAND RIVERS KENTUCKY DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. All parts of the streets described as follows.

All of Ravine Street beginning at the South west Corner of Lot 12, Block 30 NW being the intersection of Cleveland Street and Ravine Street thence running in a Northerly direction to the NE corner of Lot 1, block 27 NW and being the intersection of Ravine Street and Dover Road a distance of 1436' x 50' +or- according to the official Plat of the City of Grand Rivers recorded in Deed book 16 Page 630 of the Livingston County court House Clerks Office.

That part of Valley Road beginning at the north West Corner of lot 14, block 32 thence running in a winding easterly direction to the intersection of valley and Ravine Street on the North East side of the intersection SW corner of lot 24 and the NW Corner of Lot 31 a distance of 1275' x 70' + or - according to the Official Plat of the City of Grand Rivers Kentucky recorded in Deed Book 16 page 630 of the Livingston County Court House Clerks office.

All of Crescent Street beginning at the SW corner of lot 31 Block 25 NW being the intersection of Crescent and Ravine Street thence running East and South to the SW corner of lot 14, Block 25 NW and being the intersection of Crescent St and Suwanee Avenue a distance of 651' x 50' + or - According to the Official Plat of the City of Grand Rivers Kentucky recorded in Deed book 16 page 630.

All of Oak Street beginning at the SW corner of lot 19, Block 27 NM being the intersection of Oak St and Valley Road thence North to the NW corner of lot 15, Block 27 NW being the intersection of Dover Road and State HWY 952 and Dixon Drive and being a distance of 270' x 50' + or - according to the official plat of the City of Grand Rivers Kentucky recorded in Deed Book 16 page 630 of the Livingston County Court House Clerks Office.

All of Curve Street beginning at the intersection of Curve Street and Ravine Street at the South corner of lot 4, Block 29 and thence running in a semi-circle to the intersection of curve Street and Valley Road at the North corner of lot 6 Block 29 a distance of 530' x 50' + or - according to the official plat of the City of Grand Rivers Kentucky recorded in Deed book 16 , page 630 of the Livingston County Court House Clerks office.

All of Cleveland Street beginning at the intersection of Cleveland Street and Suwanee Avenue at the SW corner of lot 4, Block 31 and the SE corner of lot 1 Block 32, thence running North in a skewed manner to the intersection of Cleveland Street and Valley Road at the NE corner of lot 8, block 32 and the NW corner of lot 6, Block 30 a distance of 335' x 50' + or - according to the official plat of the City of Grand Rivers Kentucky recorded in deed book 16, page 630 of the Livingston County Court House Clerks Office.

SECTION 2. The City Council of Grand Rivers Kentucky is hereby authorized empowered and directed to institute, prosecute and notify pursuant to KRS 82.405 an action in Livingston Circuit Court for a judgment ordering the closing of all parts of streets and alleyways described herein

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be read on two (2) separate days and will become effective upon publication of title and a certified summary thereof.
