

**ORDINANCE 06-2012**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 02-2005 RELATING TO EMPLOYEE CLASSIFICATION AND COMPENSATION.

WHEREAS, the City has established job classifications for the type of work to be performed by each employee, and

WHEREAS, the City must establish a maximum rate of pay for each classification, and

WHEREAS, due to economic and related issues the City must adjust and increase the maximum wage for each classification listed, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS, KENTUCKY.

SECTION 1. Ordinance 02-2005 is amended as follows:

SECTION 2. There is hereby established the following classifications, number, and hourly rate of employees that may be used in the operation of City activities.

A.	Maintenance Employee	3	<del>+\$18.00</del>	<u>\$20.00</u>
B.	Maintenance Helper	2	<del>+\$10.00</del>	<u>\$12.00</u>
C.	Wastewater System Operator	2	<del>+\$18.00</del>	<u>\$20.00</u>
D.	Water Distribution Operator	2	<del>+\$18.00</del>	<u>\$20.00</u>
E.	Wastewater System Operator Trainee	2	<del>+\$10.00</del>	<u>\$12.00</u>
F.	Trainee (any class except labor)	2	<del>+\$10.00</del>	<u>\$12.00</u>
G.	Equipment Operator	2	<del>+\$18.00</del>	<u>\$20.00</u>
H.	Clerical Bookkeeper	2	<del>+\$10.00</del>	<u>\$12.00</u>
I.	Laborer	4	<del>+\$10.00</del>	<u>\$12.00</u>

SECTION 3. Any and all existing ordinances inconsistent with this amendment are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon publication.
