ORDINANCE 07-2006

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS, KENTUCKY ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS ON ALL EXISTING CITY HIGHWAYS, STREETS AND ROADS.

WHEREAS: The City recognizes the increase in traffic on City highways, streets residential and commercial, and and roads, both

with-in the city limits. WHEREAS: The City desires to mandate safe operating speeds in miles per hour (MPH) for vehicles

FOLLOWS: NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS, KENTUCKY AS
