

ORDINANCE 07-2012

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 03-2005 RELATING TO COMPENSATION FOR NON-ELECTED OFFICER

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky, recognizes it is in the best interest of the City to provide proper planning, efficiency, and economy in the management, operation and maintenance of City affairs, and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the need for changes as need requires, and

WHEREAS, due to economic and related issues the City must adjust and increase compensation for non-elected officers, and

WHEREAS, these changes have become necessary as the operation of City government has changed;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, CITY OF GRAND RIVERS, KENTUCKY THE FOLLOWING AMENDMENTS TO ORDINANCE NUMBER 03-2005 REFLECTING THE CHANGES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. ORDINANCE 03-2005, SECTION 5A IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

The office of City Administrative Officer shall have a salary of \$36,000 ~~and not to exceed \$42,000~~ \$42,000 and not to exceed \$50,000 per year. The office of Utility Manager shall have a salary of \$42,000 ~~and not exceed \$45,000~~ \$45,000 and not to exceed 50,000 per year. The office of City Clerk shall have a yearly salary of ~~\$20,800 not to exceed \$25,000~~ \$25,000 not to exceed \$30,000 as the Mayor decides depending on the requirements and qualifications of the City Clerk. Following the first 12 months of employment with the city all officers shall be eligible to draw their salary for up to fifty-two (52) days maximum within any given fiscal year as short-term sick leave as long as the absence is required in writing by an attending physician. Unused sick leave pay or benefits may not be carried over to any subsequent fiscal year.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY

If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of same shall not effect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT REPEALED.

All ordinances, resolutions, orders, or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, but only to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon publication.




