

ORDINANCE NO 06-2025

RESTAURANT TAX ORDINANCE AMENDMENT

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 03-2022 REVISING THE RATE OF THE RESTAURANT TAX ON RETAIL FOOD AND BEVERAGE SALES

**WHEREAS**, The City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky adopted Ordinance 03-2022, which established the Grand Rivers Tourism Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, City of Grand Rivers Ordinance 03-2022 implemented a restaurant tax of two percent on food and beverage retail sales to fund the Grand Rivers Tourism Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council deems it appropriate and necessary to amend the provisions of Ordinance 03-2022 to provide increased funding for the Grand Rivers Tourism Commission;

**NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF GRAND RIVERS, KENTUCKY DOES ORDAIN:**

CITY OF GRAND RIVERS ORDINANCE 03-2022 IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 3.** That the City of Grand Rivers shall provide additional funds for the operation of the Commission by imposing, pursuant to KRS 91A.400, a restaurant tax of ~~two~~ **three** percent (3%) of the food and beverage retail sales by all restaurants and clubs, private or public doing business in the city. The effective date of this restaurant tax shall be May 1, 2000.

This ordinance shall be read on two (2) separate days and will become effective upon publication of title and certified summary thereof but not earlier than October 14, 2025.




